# "LORD I CALL ..."

**Tone 8** Lord, I call upon Thee, hear me! Hear me, O Lord! Lord, I call upon Thee, hear me! Receive the voice of my prayer, when I call upon Thee!// Hear me, O Lord!

Let my prayer arise in Thy sight as incense, and let the lifting up of my hands be an evening sacrifice!// Hear me, O Lord!

Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Thy Name.

#### Tone 8 (For the Resurrection)

We offer to Thee, O Christ, our evening song and reasonable service, for Thou didst will to have mercy on us// by Thy Resurrection.

The righteous will surround me, for Thou wilt deal bountifully with me.

Lord, Lord, do not cast us away from Thy face! For Thou didst will to have mercy on us// by Thy Resurrection.

Out of the depths I cry to Thee, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice!

Rejoice, O holy Zion: Mother of the churches, the abode of God, for thou wast the first to receive remission of sins// by the Resurrection.

Let Thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!

The Word of God the Father, begotten before the ages, in the latter times willed to be incarnate of the Virgin and endured crucifixion unto death. He has saved mortal man// by His Resurrection.

If Thou, O Lord, shouldst mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with Thee.

We glorify Thee, O Lord, for Thou didst voluntarily endure the Cross for our sake. We fall down in worship before Thee, O almighty Saviour. Do not cast us away from Thy face but hear us and save us, O Lover of man,// by Thy Resurrection! For Thy Name's sake I wait for Thee, O Lord. My soul has waited for Thy word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

Glory to Thee, O Saviour Christ, Only-begotten Son of God, who wast nailed to the Cross// and resurrected from the tomb on the third day!

From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord!

We glorify Thy Resurrection from the dead, O Christ, by which Thou hast freed Adam's race from the tortures of hell,// and as God hast granted to the world eternal life and great mercy.

For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities.

# Tone 1 (For Veneable Alypius)

O most blessed Alypius, from thy youth thou didst offer thy life to Christ our God, and strengthened by Him, thou didst submit the passions of thy body to the will of the spirit. Thus, thou didst subject that which is lower to that which is higher.// Therefore, entreat the Lord that He grant our souls peace and great mercy!

# Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!

O Alypius, wise in God, thou wast revealed to be a shining beacon, illumining the earth with the splendour of thy wonders and godly deeds. Thus, at thy repose, thou wast received into the presence of the never setting Sun.// Therefore, entreat the Lord that He grant our souls peace and great mercy!

#### For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever.

O wise Father Alypius, thou wast truly the example of an immovable pillar to all monastics, for, high upon thy pillar, thou didst stand in vigilant prayer, enduring both the heat of the day and the cold of the night. Therefore, thou didst receive the divine gifts of the Spirit to heal infirmities and drive away evil passions.// Therefore, entreat the Lord that He grant our souls peace and great mercy!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

**Tone 8** *(Theotokion – Dogmatikon)* The King of heaven, because of His love for man, appeared on earth and dwelt with men. He took flesh from the pure Virgin and after assuming it, He came forth from her. The Son is one: in two natures, yet one Person. Proclaiming Him as perfect God and perfect Man, we confess Christ our God!// Entreat Him, O unwedded Mother, to have mercy on our souls.

#### APOSTICHA

**Tone 8** *(For the Resurrection)* Descending from heaven to ascend the Cross, the eternal Life has come for death to raise those who are fallen; to enlighten those in darkness.// O Jesus, our Saviour and illuminator, glory to Thee!

#### V. The Lord is King; He is robed in majesty!

We glorify Christ, who rose from the dead. He accepted the human body and soul, and freed both from suffering. His most pure soul descended to hell, which He spoiled. His holy body did not see corruption in the tomb.// He is the Redeemer of our souls.

#### Tone 8 (Theotokion)

O unwedded Virgin, who ineffably didst conceive God in the flesh, O Mother of God most high, accept the cries of thy servants, O blameless one! Grant cleansing of transgressions to all!// Receive our prayers and pray to save our souls!
