Kontakion of Saint Chad in Tone 2

When thou wast praying to Christ, O venerable Chad the choir of the angels came to call thee to thy reward. Then thou wast summoned to share in the Thrice Holy song with the seraphim. Pray thou that we may live as icons of the cherubim// rejoicing before the Trinity, the Giver of life.
