EPISTLE

The Reading from the Epistle of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Colossians.

On account of these the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience. In these you once walked, when you lived in them. Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old nature with its practices and have put on the new nature, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator.
