Tone 2 (For the Holy Martyr Tatiana)

Richly illumined by the light of the <u>Spir</u>it, thou didst spurn earthly riches, loving only those of <u>heav</u>en, and wast in<u>vest</u>ed with the strength of the <u>mar</u>tyrs as thou didst set thyself apart for immeasurable <u>suf</u>ferings.
