All-holy Trinity, have mercy on us. Lord, cleanse us from our sins. Master, pardon our iniquities. Holy One, look upon and heal our infirmities for Thy Name's sake.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; both now and ever, and unto the ages of ages. Amen.

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

Let my <u>prayer</u> arise in Thy sight as <u>in</u>cense, and let the lifting <u>up</u> of my hands be an evening <u>sac</u>rifice!// Hear <u>me</u>, O Lord!

Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Thy Name.

Tone 6 *(For the Resurrection)* Possessing victory over <u>hell</u>, O Christ, since Thou art <u>free</u> among the dead, Thou didst as<u>cend</u> the Cross raising with Thyself those who sat in the <u>shades</u> of death.// Drawing life from Thy light, O almighty Saviour, have <u>mer</u>cy on us!

The righteous will surround me, for Thou wilt deal bountifully with me.

Today Christ <u>tramples</u> on death, for He is <u>risen</u> as He said! Let us all <u>sing</u> this song, for He has granted <u>joy</u> to the world: O Light unapproachable, O <u>Foun</u>tain of life!// O Saviour almighty, have <u>mer</u>cy on us!

Out of the depths I cry to Thee, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice!

Where shall we sinners flee from Thee, Who art in all cre<u>at</u>ion? In heaven Thou <u>dwell</u>est! In hell Thou didst <u>tramp</u>le on death! In the <u>depths</u> of the sea? Even there is Thy hand, O <u>Mas</u>ter! To Thee we flee, and falling be<u>fore</u> Thee, we pray:// O Thou Who didst rise from the dead, have <u>mer</u>cy on us!

Let Thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!

Tone 6 (From the Pentecostarion, for the Ascension) The Lord has ascended into heaven that He might send the <u>Com</u>forter into the world. The heavens prepared His throne, and the <u>clouds</u> His mount. Angels marvel to see a Man high above them. The Father receives Him Whom He holds, co-eternal, in His bosom. The Holy Spirit commands all His <u>Angels</u>: "Lift up your gates, you <u>princes</u>! All you nations, <u>clap</u> your hands:// for Christ has gone up to where He <u>was</u> before!"

If Thou, O Lord, shouldst mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with Thee.

The Cherubim were amazed at Thine As<u>cen</u>sion, O Lord, beholding Thee, the God Who dost sit en<u>throned</u> upon them, ascending up<u>on</u> the clouds; and we glorify Thee, for Thy <u>mer</u>cy is good.// <u>Glory to Thee!</u>

For Thy Name's sake I wait for Thee, O Lord. My soul has waited for Thy word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

Beholding Thine Ascension on the holy <u>moun</u>tain, O Christ, the brightness of the Father's <u>glo</u>ry, we hymn the radiant appearance of Thy <u>coun</u>tenance; we worship Thy <u>Passion</u>, we honour Thy Resur<u>rec</u>tion, as we glorify Thy glorious As<u>cen</u>sion.// Have <u>mer</u>cy on us!

From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord!

Tone 6 (From the Pentecostarion, for the Fathers)

Thou wast begotten from the Father before the <u>Morn</u>ing Star, but Arius taught wrongfully that Thou wast cre<u>at</u>ed: in his ignorance he designated Thee as a <u>crea</u>ture, yet the Fathers of the Council proclaimed Thee as <u>Son</u> of God,// co-enthroned with the Father and the Holy <u>Spir</u>it.

For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities.

O Saviour, who has torn Thy <u>gar</u>ment? Who has challenged the unity of the triune <u>God</u>head? It is Arius, for he denied that Thou art equal to the <u>Fa</u>ther. Those who follow him do not believe that God took <u>flesh</u> for our sake, but the Fathers of the Council proclaimed Thee as <u>Son</u> of God,// co-enthroned with the Father and the Holy <u>Spir</u>it.

Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!

Arius fell into the a<u>byss</u> of sin, pretending blindness that he might <u>not</u> see the Light. By his purpose he became the image of <u>Ju</u>das. But the Council at Nicaea proclaimed Thee as <u>Son</u> of God,// co-enthroned with the Father and the Holy <u>Spir</u>it.

For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever.

The foolish Arius blasphemed the All-holy <u>Trin</u>ity, dividing the Persons into three different unequal <u>sub</u>stances, but the God-bearing Fathers denounced his con<u>fu</u>sion: they assembled with the zeal of E<u>lij</u>ah, destroying error with the sword of the <u>Spir</u>it,// as they were directed by the inspi<u>ra</u>tion of God.

Tone 6 (From the Pentecostarion, for the Fathers) Today let us praise the mystical trumpets of the <u>Spir</u>it, the God-bearing <u>Fa</u>thers, who stand in the midst of the Church, singing true the<u>ology</u>, praising the changeless <u>Trin</u>ity! They laid low the errors of <u>Ar</u>ius and upheld the <u>Orth</u>odox Faith.// They always entreat the Lord to have <u>mer</u>cy on our souls.

Tone 6 (*Theotokion – Dogmatikon*)

Who will not bless thee, O most holy <u>Virgin?</u> Who will not sing of thy most pure <u>child</u>bearing? The only-begotten Son shone timelessly from the <u>Fa</u>ther, but from thee He was ineffably in<u>car</u>nate. God by nature, yet <u>Man</u> for our sake, not two persons, but one known in two <u>na</u>tures. Entreat Him, O pure and all-blessed <u>Lady</u>,// to have <u>mer</u>cy on our souls!

OLD TESTAMENT READINGS The reading from the book of Genesis.

When Abram heard his brother Lot was taken captive, he armed his three hundred and eighteen trained servants, born in his own house, and went in pursuit as far as Dan. So he divided his forces against them by night, and he and his servants attacked and pursued them as far as Hobah, north of Damascus. So he brought back all the cavalry of Sodom, and also brought back his brother Lot and his goods, as well as the women and the people. Then the king of Sodom went out to meet him at the Valley of Shaveh (that is, the King's Valley), after his return from the slaughter of Chedorlaomer and the kings with him. Now Melchizedek the king of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was the priest of God Most High. He blessed Abram and said, "Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth; and blessed be God Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hands."

The reading from the book of Deuteronomy.

Moses spoke to the sons of Israel: "Behold, I am delivering the land in your presence; go in and inherit the land I swore to your fathers – to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob – to give it to them and their seed after them. So I spoke to you at that time, saying, 'I alone am not able to bear you. The Lord your God multiplied you, and here you are today, as the stars of heaven in multitude. May the Lord God of your fathers make you a thousand times more numerous than you are, and bless you, just as He said.' So I took from you wise, understanding, and knowledgeable men and made them leaders over you: leaders of thousands, of hundreds, of fifties, and of tens; judges to interpret the law for you. Then I commanded your judges at that time, saying, 'Hear the cases between your brethren, and judge righteously between a man and his brother or the resident alien with him. You shall not show partiality in judgement; you shall judge the small and the great; you shall not shrink before any man's presence, for the judgement is God's. The case too hard for you, bring to me, and I will hear it.'''

The reading from the book of Deuteronomy.

Moses spoke to the sons of Israel: "Indeed, heaven and heaven of heaven belong to the Lord your God, also the earth and everything in it. The Lord chose your fathers to love them; and He chose their seed after them, you above all nations, as it is this day. Therefore circumcise the foreskin of your heart, and do not be stiff-necked any longer. For the Lord your God is God of gods, and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality nor takes a bribe. He administers justice for the resident alien, the fatherless, and the widow, and loves the resident alien, giving him food and clothing. You shall fear the Lord your God; you shall serve Him, and hold fast to Him, and take oaths in His name. He is your boast and your God, who did these great and glorious things for you, the things you saw with your own eyes."

APOSTICHA

Tone 6 *(For the Resurrection)* Thy Resurrection, O Christ our <u>Saviour</u>, the Angels in <u>heav</u>en sing! Enable <u>us</u> on earth// to glorify Thee in <u>pur</u>ity of heart!

Having been crucified as <u>Thou</u> didst will, by Thy burial Thou didst capture <u>death</u>, O Christ, rising on the third day as God in <u>glo</u>ry,// granting the world unending life and great <u>mercy</u>!

Tone 4 (From the Pentecostarion, for the Fathers)

Come, all Orthodox <u>Church</u>es, let us celebrate today in faith and true <u>wor</u>ship the <u>year</u>ly commemoration of the divinely-arrayed <u>Fa</u>thers who gathered at Nicaea from through<u>out</u> the world! There they refuted the godless <u>teach</u>ing of <u>Ar</u>ius, banishing him from the Catholic Church by a decree of the <u>coun</u>cil. They taught all to confess openly the <u>Son</u> of God, consubstantial and co-e<u>ter</u>nal with the <u>Fa</u>ther, proclaiming this with precision and true worship in the <u>Sym</u>bol of Faith. Therefore, as we faithfully follow their divine <u>doc</u>trines, let us worship the Father, the Son, and the most <u>Holy Spir</u>it,// the consubstantial Trinity in one <u>God</u>head!
